Important Information

- Please **fill up on gas** well before arriving at Camp Eagle. The nearest reliable gas station is over an hour away.
- Wifi is available at the main office; **We do not have cell service.**
- Unless you're staying in the Trinity building, you must **bring your own bedding & towels.**
- We do not allow smoking inside our rooms. Smoking outside on the grounds is allowed.
- RV & Tent Camping costs \$5 per person per night. This is payable at the front gate through cash or card. Camp Eagle does not provide any RV hookups.
- If you're camping in the RV/Tent field, feel free to use any of the bathrooms around main camp or the barn. If you'd like to shower, head up to the bathhouse by the screen shelters.
- We do not allow ground fires. Camp stoves, however, are allowed.
- Please be moved out of your rooms by 3:00pm Sunday.
- Meals will be available throughout the weekend from Camp Eagle and can be paid for with cash or card.
- The Barn will be the main hub of the race. Please direct any race-specific questions there.
- If you're in urgent need of assistance and can't find a staff member, go to the office foyer, use the walkie beneath the TV, and ask for Kyle. He'll be there to help in a few minutes.
- **Helmets must be worn anytime you're on your bike.**
- Please do not get on any high elements or participate in any Camp Eagle activities without the permission & supervision of a Camp Eagle staff member.
